## Tuition Grants and Scholarships

We have several ways to help families save on the cost of tuition.

**EdChoice Expansion Scholarship** - Families with students entering kindergarten through fifth grade in 2018-19 may qualify for this income-based scholarship that can pay the entire cost of tuition. For example, a family of four with an income of \$50,200 or less may qualify. Application forms are available in the school office. We can help you complete the application forms.

**School, Church and Diocese Based Grants and Scholarships – – All are encouraged to apply. All applications are considered.** Please apply through the FACTS program as early as possible. Applications filed by March 15 are eligible for diocesan grants. Families can apply by logging into your existing FACTS account or going to [www.factstuitionaid.com](http://www.factstuitionaid.com).

- Required documentation includes 2017 W-2 and 2016 or 2017 tax returns.
- One application per family, no fee.
- If you do not have Internet access or need help, please contact the school and we will help you file the application.

**Volunteer Program** – School volunteers can earn a \$150 credit toward the cost of tuition. The Volunteer Program Handbook will be available at the start of the school year.

**SCRIPS Buying Program** – After paying a small registration fee, families can make on-line purchases for everyday products and services, earning tuition credits in the process. Information about how to sign up is available in the office and on the school website.
